MEETING MINUTES

Sheboygan Falls Park Board Meeting
Wednesday, April 12th, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 PM by Board President, Bob Hackel.

Members Present: Bob Hackel, Bob Hall, Dan Riviers, and Denise Marquis.

Absent: Peter Weber, June Cole and Brian Beeck

Others Present: Mayor Randy Meyer, DPW Jerry Benzschawel, Shad Tempas, Shirl Breunig, and Tammy Meyer.

Minutes: The minutes of the March 8th, 2016 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Bob Hall to approve, seconded by Dan Riviers. Motion passed.

Appearances:

1. Jack Liebham confirmed his proposed Eagle Scout project to lead the community tree planting event has been approved by his leaders. He is working on recruiting volunteers for tree planting.
2. Nathaniel Darling from Fat Kats Mountain Bike Club in Sheboygan asked if his group could host a bike race at Rochester Park on November 12th. He was invited to return to a future Park Board meeting with maps of proposed courses.

Public Works Department Report: DPW Jerry Benzschawel reported old playground equipment has been removed and the site is ready for installation of new playground equipment at Rochester Park. A tree will be moved away from new equipment.

General:

1. Rochester Park - Playground equipment upgrade - color selection. Bob Hall made a motion to select forest green as the primary color of new equipment. Seconded by Dan Riviers. Motion passed.
2. Park playground equipment - Long Range Plan. Dan Riviers will review the status reports of current playground equipment in order to schedule a replacement schedule for Woodview Park, Kay Meadows Park and River Park.
3. Community Tree Planting Program - Bob Hackel met with Jack Liebham to coordinate plans for tree planting.
4. Ice rink - On hold until we hear back from Chuck Otte regarding funding.
5. Trowbridge Property - As a possible extension of west side park and access to Sheboygan River, Mayor Meyer talked to DNR about grant funding through a comprehensive outdoor recreation plan. Property is not on the market yet. Bob Hall made a motion to appraise property at a cost not to exceed \$500. Seconded by Dan Riviers. Motion passed. Shad Tempas will contact owners.

6. Geese deterrent product - DPW will purchase a solar powered floating device that will act as a deterrent for geese within a 3.5 acre radius.

New Business:

1. Shad Tempas asked about plans for mowing path and other areas at Bluebird Park. Jerry Benzschawel will look at options and return with cost estimates.
2. Denise Marquis asked if there are any long range plans for maintaining River Walk path. Timbers are rotting and the surface is eroding from heavy rains on a steep slope.. Occasional dirt bike traffic also cause damage. Jerry Benzschawel will look at conditions.

A motion was made by Bob Hall to adjourn the meeting. Second by Dan Riviers.
Meeting adjourned at 7:00.
