MEETING MINUTES

Sheboygan Falls Park Board Meeting
Wednesday, March 14, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 5:15 PM by Board President, Bob Hackel.

Members Present: Bob Hackel, Bob Hall, Dan Riviers, Chuck Otte, Pete Weber, and Denise Marquis.

Absent: Brian Beeck

Others Present: Shirl Breunig

Minutes: The minutes of the January 10th, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Pete Weber to approve, seconded by Bob Hall. Motion passed.

Appearances:

1. Austin McKay reported 1 hole sponsor so far for Disc Golf Course at Rochester Park. He is working with Sabrina Dittman to catalog progress of Course development. He has begun working on cleaning out brush in woods along the river. He has contacted Boy Scouts for help with further cleanup.

Public Works Department Report: DPW Jerry Benzschawel was unable to attend.

General:

1. 2018 Tree planting date is April 28th, beginning at Bluebird Lane, 8:00AM. Bob Hackel contacted Boy Scouts, and youth groups from St. Paul's, Blessed Trinity for possible help. Chuck Otte said he spread the word at the high school and has received some good response, especially from those who need a service project to work on.
2. Ice Rink Update - Chuck Otte reported the new ice rink was a complete success. We had great weather for skating and the rink was busy.
3. Disc golf course update. See Austin McKay's report.
4. Goose Roundup in River Park. Nothing new to report.
5. West Side park update. No one present to report.
6. Kayak launch- Chuck Otte. Grant is on hold.
7. Bay Lake Regional Planning Commission grant - A motion was made by Chuck Otte and seconded by Dan Riviers to set aside \$2500 (25% matching funds) for a \$10,000 grant to fund the purchase of 2.5" diameter trees to plant directly into our parks. Motion approved. Per council approval of the matching funds, Denise Marquis will work with Jerry Benzschawel to complete grant application by April 9th. Matching funds can be in the form of city labor used to plant trees.

New Business:

1. A request was made by a citizen group led by Roy York to add a new neighborhood park on two city owned parcels adjacent to the Sheboygan River running along Water Street/Cleveland Street. Pete Weber suggested referring the request to the Common Council's Property Committee for further review. A long range plan for the Tecumseh property could also be studied for future park use and/or river trail access.

A motion was made by Bob Hall to adjourn the meeting. Second by Pete Weber.
